

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS/REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO B. Sc. (Hons.)
NURSING COURSE FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020

1. MINIMUM CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR REGISTRATION:

- i. **Age:-** The Candidate should have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December 2019. The candidates completing the age of 17 years on 1st January 2020 or later will not be eligible. The upper age limit is 30 years as on 31/12/2019 further provided that this upper age limit is relaxed by a period of five years for the candidates belonging to SC/ST.
- ii. **Qualifying Examination:** - A candidate seeking admission to First year B. Sc. (Hons.) Nursing Course must have passed Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by CBSE/Council of the Indian School Certificate Examination (12years course) from a recognized school or an examination recognized as equivalent to, with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of 4 subjects including English (Core/Elective), Physics, Chemistry and Biology provided the student has passed in each subject separately.
- iii. **Only women candidates are eligible for the course.**
- iv. The criterion for deciding the region of the candidate for B. Sc. (Hons.) Nursing course 2019, (who have passed/appeared in the Senior School Certificate Examination or an examination recognized as equivalent to, through Patrachar/Correspondence/Open School) will be the location of the school. The candidate must have got herself registered with any school for the purpose.
